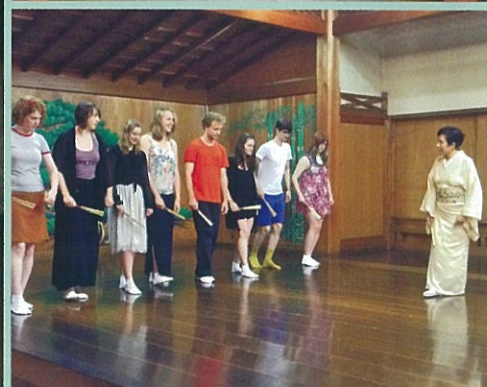
What's behind Kyoto's superbly sophisticated traditional heritage?

English

#### Accommodation:

On-campus dorms + one-night World Heritage temple stay.

#### Program Fee:

120,000 yen

(including accommodation, field trips, admissions and related transportation, temple stay and welcome/farewell parties; does not include daily meals, personal expenses or international travel/airport shuttle).

March 1 - April 30, 2017
