i-Portunus – Second Pilot Phase

i-Portunus supports the mobility of artists, creators and cultural professionals among all countries participating in the Creative Europe programme. This second pilot phase of i-Portunus was selected and is co-funded by the Creative Europe Programme of the European Union and a consortium, headed by Goethe-Institut together with Institut français and Izolyatsia. This second pilot phase will run from end of 2020 to end of 2021.

Through a demand-driven mobility scheme and a straightforward but flexible application process, i-Portunus answers to existing and new needs of the creative sectors to support short-term mobility.

New Calls open on 15 February 2021 with deadline on 15 April 2021

Who can apply?

- **composers, musicians and singers**, preferably in classical music, jazz, and traditional music genres
- **artists, creators and cultural professionals** active in cultural heritage

What can you apply for?

Short-term **mobility** in the context of:

- international collaboration
- a production-oriented residency
- professional development activities

When: mobility between 16 July and 30 November 2021, conditions permitting.

Duration: between 7 and 60 days.

Maximum grant per person: 3.000,00 EUR.

Deadline for submission of applications: **15 April 2021**.
